INVITATION TO REGISTER WITH SACLAP AS CANDIDATES ON THE SPECIAL CETA FUNDED STRUCTURED CANDIDACY PROGRAMME.

SACLAP invites newly graduated young people with qualifications in Landscape Technology, Landscape Architecture and Horticulture to a special candidacy programme that is structured to assist with mentorship and practical training towards final registration in any of the SACLAP professional categories.

This project is aimed at improving the throughput between graduation from a tertiary institution, candidacy and eventually registering as a professional. It is a direct intervention as a result of the sentiments expressed by the young people that attended the black coffee workshop in 2018 about the existing challenges. This intervention will also address the call from government to transform the profession. It is envisaged that this project will assist SACLAP with improving the demographics of the register of professionals.

As this is the first time SACLAP is embarking on this project only a limited number will be enrolled in this programme this year.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must have successfully completed a tertiary qualification.
- Must be a South African citizen
- Must be eligible for registration in one of the SACLAP candidate registration categories
- Must be available to attend meetings, seminars and training programmes

Preference will be given to the following

- Females and persons with disabilities
- Persons residing in Gauteng especially Tshwane
- Graduates that have not been able to get candidacy/ practical training opportunities
- Candidates that are already working in the industry and have a registered professional willing to act as their mentor on this programme (SACLAP may assist with this)

This project is funded by the construction education and training authority (CETA) for a 3-year structured candidacy programme. CETA terms and conditions must be strictly adhered to. (These will be outlined to shortlisted applicants)
